The Madison Marriage Ministries will host its annual marriage enrichment seminar with presenter, Dr. Gary Thomas, author of Sacred Marriage. The seminar is Saturday, January 29, from 9:00 AM to 4:00 PM at City Church (formerly Lake City Church), 4909 E Buckeye Road in Madison.

Dr. Thomas will explore with couples the query, "What if God designed marriage to make us holy instead of happy?" Through four seminar sessions he will help couples
