## Mobile Food Pantry News

Thanks to everyone who came to help with this month's food distribution. We helped 78 families which included 191 persons, 46 children and 37 seniors. There were 12 first time visitors to the pantry and 54 of the families reported as being unemployed.

I talked with Mona at Second Harvest and we are going to change the time of food distribution to 11:15 to 12:15. This change will assure that everyone that needs food will be there when we start distributing. Especially now that the weather is hot we want to make sure the food stays cold. This time change will not affect our set up time the truck will still arrive at 11:00 am. If we get started distributing a little later than 11:15 that's okay.
