PLEASE OBSERVE THE FOLLOWING CEMETERY RULES

Glass containers are not to be placed on or at any gravesite.

Urns and containers that are not a part of the monument, are not to be placed on the grass around the monuments or markers, or to be placed in such a manner that they are apt to fall on the grass and impede mowing.

No metal stakes, fences or wire fasteners are to be put into the ground. It is preferred that there be no flower beds at the gravesite, but if there is, they must be trimmed and maintained by the family. If not, they will be removed. Perpetual Care of the Cemetery does not include the care of individual lots.

Do not drive or park on the grass at any time.



What's special about Sunday, June 10?

It is the day that we celebrate the feast of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ or Corpus Christi. This Feast goes back to the 13th century but it celebrates something much older; the institution of the Sacrament of Holy Communion. This feast is either celebrated on the Thursday after Trinity Sunday or as it is in the Diocese of Madison on the Sunday after Trinity Sunday.

The Feast of Corpus Christi, now called the Feast of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, began with an Augustinian nun, Juliana of Liege, who longed for a special feast in honor of the Blessed Sacrament. Beginning in 1208 Juliana had repeated visions of the full moon with a dark spot in it which signified the absence of such a feast. Juliana kept her visions secret for 20 years but eventually told them to her confessor who relayed them on to the local bishop. In 1246 Bishop Robert Thoreti ordered a celebration of Corpus Christi to be held each year. After Bishop Robert's death Pope Urban IV issued a Papal Bull which made Corpus Christi a feast throughout the entire Latin Rite. Pope Urban asked St. Thomas Aquinas to compose the liturgy for the feast.

Corpus Christi Procession Sunday, June 10

As a part of Corpus Christi Sunday there will be a 9:30 Mass instead of the usual 9:00 a.m. Mass. At this Mass Fr. Faustino has requested that all second and third graders who have received their first Holy Communion be part of the procession to go from Saint Mary Church to Saint Augustine following the 9:30 Mass. If possible Father has requested that the second graders wear their first communion clothes. Children may sit with their families for Mass and then join the beginning of the procession. Please call the office if your children will be able to participate.

TEC Retreat Coming to Kieler! The next retreat will be offered at Immaculate Conception in Kieler from June 8-10. TEC stands for Together Encountering Christ. It's a jam-packed event.
