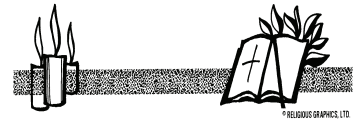

Many of our clients are helping to unload the truck and that is very helpful. This month we served 111 families that included 12 first time visitors to the pantry, 74 children under 18, 142 adults and 52 seniors. Seventy-three reported as being unemployed.
