## FASTING & ABSTAINING

Catholics who have celebrated their 14th birthday are to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, all Fridays in Lent and Good Friday.

Catholics who have celebrated their 18th birthday, until they celebrate their 59th birthday, are to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.

Those who are bound to this regulation may eat only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted if necessary to maintain strength according to one's needs, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted.

**Sister Rose Frances Phalin** died Monday, January 14, 2013 at Villa St. Joseph, LaCrosse. She was in the 79th year of her religious profession.

Sister Rose Frances was principal and taught 7th & 8th grades here at St. Mary's School in the early and mid 1940's—A sister none ever forgot, touching many lives.

She served as a teacher and/or principal for 52 years in Wisconsin, Guam, Iowa and Washington, including 14 years at St. Patrick's, Onalaska.

Sister Rose Frances retired to St. Rose Convent, LaCrosse in 1989 and was coordinator of chapel tours until 1987. She made Villa St. Joseph her home in 2007.

After almost 80 years as a Religious Sister, may she now rest in eternal peace with all her deceased students. Requiescat in pace.
