### PLEASE OBSERVE THE FOLLOWING CEMETERY RULES

Glass containers are not to be placed on or at any gravesite. Urns and containers that are not a part of the monument, are not to be placed on the grass around the monuments or markers, or to be placed in such a manner that they are apt to fall on the grass and impede mowing. No metal stakes, fences or wire fasteners are to be put into the ground. It is preferred that there be no flower beds at the gravesite, but if there is, they must be trimmed and maintained by the family. If not, they will be removed. Perpetual Care of the Cemetery does not include the care of individual lots. Do not drive or park on the grass at any time.
