CORPUS CHRISTI SUNDAY

St. Mary & St. Augustine will have a combined celebration of Corpus Christi on June 2. Mass will be celebrated at St. Mary at 9:30am with Fr. Faustino celebrating. There will be no 9am Mass. Immediately after Mass, there will be a Eucharistic procession to St. Augustine's with stops along the way.
