Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Feast Day is July 16th. In honor of the Feast Day, Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Scapulars will be handed out at Mass next weekend, July 13th and 14th.

This weekend we welcome Fr. George Bergin SVD with the Divine Word Missionaries.

The Divine Word Missionaries are an international religious community of missionary Priests and Brothers who serve in 70 countries. Fr. George grew up in Beaver Dam, WI where he was a teacher and Dean of Students. For 5 years he worked at the Mission Center in Techny, IL in the Annuities Department and as Director of Mission Appeals and making sure that Missionaries working overseas will receive the supplies they needed to do their ministry. These supplies went from medications and books, to boats and socks. For 5 years Father George lived in a Boston Parish and was a High School Religion teacher. He was a Vocation Director for 16 years and was a staff member of the Miramar Retreat Center in Duxbury, MA where he ministers as counselor for substance abuse victims.

Mobile Pantry June Report

Thanks for all of you who volunteered at the pantry in June. We had 94 families receive food with 22 families being first time visitors. The families include 240 individuals, 51 under 18, 148 adults and 41 seniors. Every month for the past two years we have had up to 15 people who have come for food volunteer to help us unload the truck, with smaller numbers helping to distribute food and clean up. Now due to new Second Harvest regulations these individuals no longer will be able to participate as volunteers. This puts our pantry in jeopardy as we do not have sufficient volunteers from the parish showing up to do the required work. So if you think that you will be able to donate sometime on the third Friday of the month to help please let Linda know. The truck arrives at 9:30 and with adequate help we can be done by Noon. We would like to be able to continue this valuable service that we provide for the area. Linda
