

Memorization Questions 3rd grade

1. Can there be more than one God?

No, there cannot be more than one God because there cannot be two supreme beings.

2. Why must there be a God?

There must be a God because everything in the world comes from something else, every effect has a cause. If we trace things back to their beginning, we will eventually find the something which existed before everything else. That something is God.

3. How has God shown His love for us?

God has shown His love for us by (1) making and keeping promises to us, (2) by freeing us from Hell and saving us for Heaven, and (3) by loving each of us with the love of a good and caring father.

4. How should we respond to God's goodness?

We should respond to God's goodness by (1) finding joy in God, and (2) worshipping and serving Him.

5. In what ways do we worship God?

We worship God in the liturgy, especially in the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass, and when we pray by ourselves or with our families. The liturgy is the public prayer of God's Family, the Church. We also worship God by serving Him in all that we do.

6. How was man created?

After God created the universe, He made man's body out of the dust of the earth. That is, out of matter. Then God put a soul into man's body.

7. What special gifts did God give to Adam and Eve?

God gave Adam and Eve perfect health of body, mind and soul. Best of all, God put His own life in their bodies and souls. If Adam and Eve had obeyed God they would have kept this life and would have entered Heaven without having to die first.
