

## Memorization Questions 7<sup>th</sup> grade

1. Why is God all-merciful?

God is all-merciful because there is no end to His mercy. God will forgive any sin if the person who committed the sin confesses it with true sorrow and does not intend to commit it again.

2. Why is God all-just?

God is all-just because He is completely honest and fair with everyone.

3. Where are the angels who obeyed God?
