### NOVENA FOR THE UNBORN

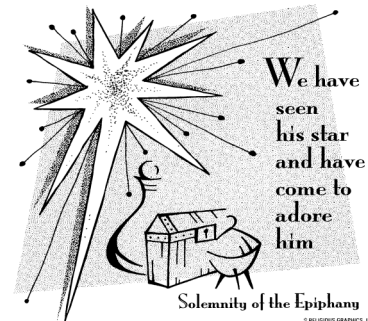
There will be a Novena for the Unborn from January 14 to the 22nd, in memory of all those who have died in abortion. We will say the prayers after the 8:00 morning Mass.
