

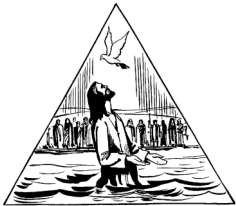

Free—no qualifications—all welcome. Bring your own container to take food home.

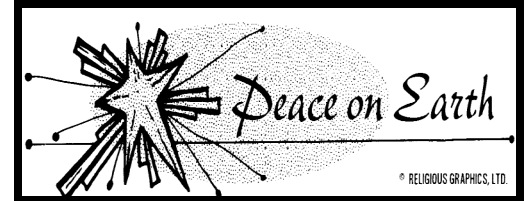
NOVENA FOR THE UNBORN
